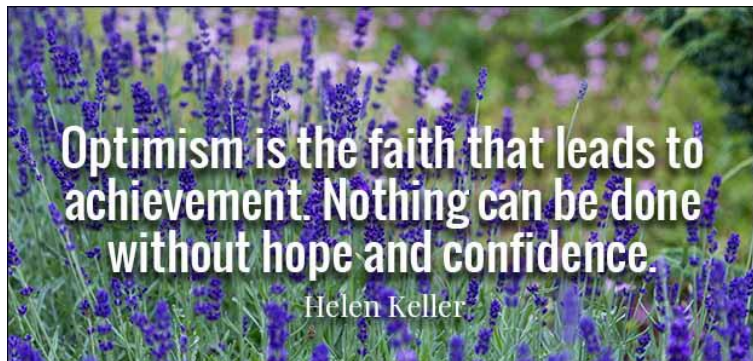


### Thought for the week
