Children in Reception, Y1 and Y2 are given free fruit through a government scheme. All other children are allowed to bring a snack of fruit for playtime if they would like.

School dinners are free for all children in Reception, Y1 and Y2 and children who are registered as free school meals. Otherwise it is £2.10 per day.
