Afterschool clubs start on Monday. Children should only stay for clubs if there has been a consent form completed and returned to the office please.

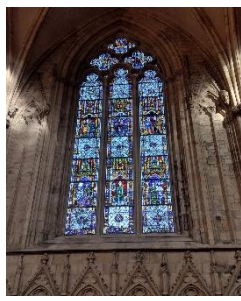
- Sign Language Club is now full however if you need childcare on a Monday this can be provided.
