School Day

The school day continues to be 8.45am – 3.15pm, with children being able to access the premises from 8.35am when there is a member of staff on duty.

Any children arriving in school before 8.35am will need to go to breakfast club, this is charged at £2 per day.

Please ensure children arriving in school punctually for an 8.45am start. Did you know, being late by 15 minutes each day is the same as missing two weeks of school per year!

At the end of the school day you are invited to enter the playground once the gate is opened at 3.15pm. This is safer than everyone congregating on the footpath by the road which is becoming increasingly busy. Children will be brought out and handed over to you in class order 1, 2, 3, 4 .
