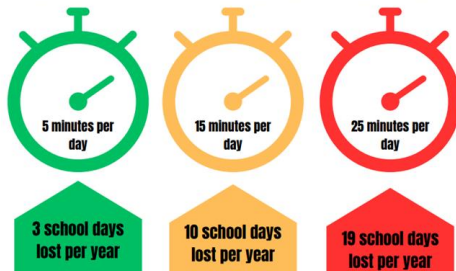


Calendar for after half term
