Bikeability

Year 6 children – please ensure you have completed the online forms that were sent through to you and also the children need to remember to their bikes and helmets on Monday. Reminders

The school day starts at 8.45am – registers close at that time, so please ensure your child is in school for that time. There will be two members of staff on the gates from 8.35am to let them in. Until staff are at the gate, you are responsible for your own children please, this applies at all times to non-school age children who accompany you to school.

Please can we ask at collection time that you come through the double gates into the school grounds and wait there, as this is safer than waiting on the roadside. It is also very difficult to see parents who are waiting round near the post box. This is especially important for parents of children in class 1 and 2.

Parking at the Village Hall should ease on an afternoon now that afterschool clubs are starting but please can we remind you to park closely and considerately so that we can accommodate everyone and do not need to park on the roadside or outside of other properties.

Lunches
